Mahatma Gandhi

His name is Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, commonly known as Mahatma Gandhi. He was born October 12, 1887 in Porbandar, India. Gandhi has three brothers and he is the son of Karamchand Gandhi (father) and Putlibai (mother). In 1883, aged 13 he got married to Kasturba Makanji, who was 10 years old. He graduated in law in London, England.

In 1891 Gandhi returned to India to do his job. Two years later, he went to South Africa (at the time it was a British colony), where he started a peace movement by fighting for the rights of Hindus. He went back to India in 1914 to propagate his movement which is against violence (Satyagraha). With a lot of supporters at the moment, in 1822, he organized a strike against tax increase, where a police station was burned. Arrested in this strike he considered himself as guilty and was sentenced to six years, but he got out in 1924.

The Indians were considered as 2nd class citizens, by this point of view, Gandhi went to London to ask independence for India. His trip wasn't worth too much but, nevertheless, thousands of people were waiting for him in Africa. Not lowered his hands, he said that he will not stop trying to get the independence for India. He went to jail again. The English government sent Sir Cripps to make an arrangement with Mahatma Gandhi to make an agreement to bring about the independence of India, however the "Big man" just wanted freedom for Africa.

Back into peace movement he went to jail once more for two years. In 1947, India as now has independence but there was a rift between Hindus and Muslims. By this misunderstanding and because the Muslims wanted an independent state (Pakistan) there were thousands of corpses in the streets. Gandhi stops eating (for the 15th time), and he accepted the division of India. Aged 78, he was assassinated by a Hindu in January 30, 1948. Gandhi just got the Nobel peace prize after he died, in 1989. He has several films in his honor, such as: "Gandhi", "Gandhi, my father", "Lage Raho Munna Bhai" and "The Making of the Mahatma".

During his life, he said greats phrases, like:

- -"Hapiness is when what you think, what you say, and what you do are in harmony"
- -"First they ignore you, then they ridicule you, then they fight you, and then you win"
- -"Non-violence requires a double faith, faith in God and also faith in man."

Bake in a preheated oven for 25 to 30 minutes. Finally allow to cool.



You may be asking yourself "But, where do you use those costumes?", well, there are lots of conventions all over the world where cosplayers get around, showing off their costumes an even taking group cosplaying photos (we call group cosplaying when they all get together as characters from the same anime/manga/video game). In Portugal, these conventions happen regularly, mostly in Lisbon and Porto; people from all over the country travel to these cities just to be able to go to these fun social weekends.

Anime conventions are mostly organized in pavilions where merchandizing and food stalls are available with whole new and different foods to taste and cute and unique objects to buy. There are also special places in the convention dedicated to video and board/card games, so beloved by some of the otaku (fan of manga and anime). It is costume to have some workshops about Japanese culture with special Japanese guests and lots of contests are available such as video games, karaoke, and the most wanted and watched of them all – the cosplay contest.

The contest is competition where you participate to show off your costume and acting ability. It is, usually just for fun. But there is a more serious cosplay contest in Europe - the Eurocosplay – it has lots of eliminatories so that the best cosplayer in the country is the one who will represent it internationally. These competitions consist in a performance by each cosplayer. This act, called a skit, is a small theatrical representation of the character they are dressed as, it can be anything you want, and so the sky is the limit! The contestant is then judged on how well the character was represented – in costume and in personality. This year's Portuguese winner was Leoneor Garcia, who played Mirka Fortuna, from the anime Trinaty Blood; she will represent Portugal in the Eurocosplay.

If you ever participate, remember, you may do it for fun, and it will be, and, if your costume is a good one, you will receive lots of respect in the community. **How to get a cosplay?**

You always have two choices to get a cosplay – or you make it or you buy it. It's easier to buy, of course, but good cosplays are no less than 90 euros, and only the costume, you still need the wig and accessories. So to buy a cosplay gets pretty expensive; plus, if you buy it all, you can't participate on the contests.

In my opinion it's better to make it. Yes, it is hard work, especially making a big cosplay, but it is always more rewarding when people say "Wow, it looks great!" and you say "Thanks, I made it all by myself!" right?

Steps and tips for a good homemade cosplay

- 1 Choose your character.
- 2 Make a plan of the costume: be sure to know what you will need for that costume before you start (which cloths, accessories, wig, etc)
- 3 Break the cosplay into parts: chose which parts you will make first and how you will make them.
- 4 Go shopping: go buy the fabrics for the costume, be sure to buy more than you think you will need! You can also go to cheap cloths stores and see if there are any pieces that you can modify to make your costume; it's always some time you spare.
- 5 Get started: measure yourself and start doing the patterns for your outfit. Be sure to cut a little larger than the pattern so it will fit correctly after you trimmed off the edges and sewn.
- 6 Test it: be sure it fits you.

 Dress it up and do some
 adjustments that it may need to be
 perfect.
- 7 Accessories and wigs: most characters have hair colors that you can't find naturally, so, instead of painting your own hair, you can buy a wig to do the character. The same goes to the accessories, like weapons, those can be hard to make, but you can always find a similar one in a store and then modify it.
- 8 Time to shine! Go out and show off your awesome new homemade cosplay!


